This past December 9th has marked the end of the exams for Senior 6 finalists and we thank God that this period has gone well. It has been a busy time as students had credits



to make up and classes to finish since 17th October because of time we were closed due to Covid. A lot has been going on for me also as I must pick up exams every day at 8am in Masaka and return them at 1pm. Then I collect another set and again return them to the Masaka government testing office at

5pm. I am also in charge of the supervision and report writing during this time.

We thank God that all our girls have completed without anyone falling sick. We pray that when their test results come back, they all will have passed and will qualify for university acceptance.

Thank you so much to so many donors for the support through these last six years that you have sponsored so many St. Aloysius students. The majority of our girls are now at home, but as a school we keep on asking their parents, how they are faring?

The last of the students, except the 6 girls who live at St. Aloysius full time, have gone home for the holidays. Sister Maria Theresa now begins to plan for the 2023 new school year by interviewing prospective first year students and their parents. She also begins budgeting for new classroom supplies, as well as the food and uniforms budget. The end of January, when new and all returning students begin to arrive, is just around the corner for Sister!

On the 15th of each month, checks will be deposited into the account for St. Aloysius Girls School, then wired to Uganda. \$50 dollars sent each month can keep a girl in school and help with teachers' salary! It costs \$500 a year for tuition, room, board and uniform. The extra \$100 is to cover increased cost of teacher salaries.
